Beidh Gaelscoil Naomh Pádraig ag obair i dtreo an t-ochtú Brat Glas as i mbliana. Faoi láthair tá coiste glas nua againn sa scoil mar sin, beimid ag léanuint leis an 'obair glas' sa scoil agus ag cur leis.

Seo a leanas na rudaí atá ar siúl faoi láthair sa scoil:

- Tá bosca glas i ngach seomra ranga áit ina ndéantar athchúrsáil ar pháipéar, cáirtpháipéar agus tetra pack.
- Tá bosca gorm i ngach seomra ranga chun múiriniú a dhéanamh ar chraiceann torthaí agus ar uile.
- Ón mhí seo ar aghaidh ní bheidh cead ag do pháiste buidéal plaisteach (aon úsáid) a thabhairt ar scoil.
- **Táimid fós ag bailiú sean-stampaí, sean chártaí phoist, sean ghutháin agus cartún dúch agus cadhnaí.**
- **Tá na Ranganna 1-6 ag úsáid a tuaille féin in ionad páipéar tuaille ar scoil chun a lámha a thriomiú.**
- Beidh ealaíon ar siúl i ngach seomra ranga i rith na bliana bunaithe ar athchúrsáil chomh maith le obair scoile O.S.I.E bunaithe ar Athrú Aeráide, Laighdú, Athchúrsáil agus Athúsáid
- Oíche Shamhna - Siúlóid na gCailleach **(25/10/18)**
- Rang 1 go Rang 6: beidh teastas ar fáil do na páistí a smaoinigh ar athchúrsáil nó athúsáid agus iad ag gléasadh suas.
- Tá páistí ó Rang 6 ag déanamh cinnte go bhfuilimid ag múchadh na soilse agus aon rud leictreonach nach bhfuil in úsáid. Chomh maith le sin, beidh an Coiste ag féachaint ar chúrsaí teas ag coiméad súil ar an méadar gáis agus an méadar leictreach.
- Beimid ag coiméad súil géar ar an méadar uisce agus ag baint triail as bealaí eagsúla chun gearradh siar ar an méid uisce a úsáideann an scoil.
- **Beidh Seachtain Athrú Aeráide a reachtáil sa scoil éineacht le An Taisce ar an 14-20ú Deireadh Fomhair. Beidh na múinteoirí ag deanmhaí pé ar athrú aeráide sna ranganna. Beidh deis ag an bun ranganna bléibhlíní a chur i rith an tseachtain seo. Beidh mórshuíl á néagrú ag an gCoiste Glas éineacht le Comhairle na ndaltaí ar an Aoine an 18ú Deireadh Fómhair chun ár mothúcháin a leiriú nach bhfuil ár Rialtas ag deanmhaí go leor chun Athrú Aeráide a laghdú.**
- **I mbliana beimid ag díriú isteach ar 'Saoránacht Dhomhanda :Timpeallacht Mhuirí don ochtú mbrat ach beidh a thuilleadh eolais faoi seo ar ball.**
- **Ná déanaigí dearmad go bhfuil ár lá 'siúl ar scoil' againn ar laethanta Dé Máirt agus ár lá 'rothaíocht ar scoil' againn gach Céadaoin.**

Iarraim ort mar thuismitheoir cabhrú linn leis an obair seo agus gan aon scragall stán nó scannán cumhdaithe, ar lón do plón do pháiste. Is fearr úsáid a bhaint as a leithead de pháipéar cistine, mála

Green Schools: 8th Green Flag 2019/20

The school will be working towards our 8th eight green flag during this school year therefore we will be continuing on with our **Green** work. Our Green School Committee are already up and running and are taking their job very seriously. The following is a list of all the work we do to retain the seven green flags we have acquired to date:

- We have a green bin in each classroom where paper, card board and tetra pack can be recycled
- We also have a blue bin where the children can dispose of fruit skins etc. This is then brought out to the compost bin.
- **Starting from the beginning of Oct we are encouraging children not to use single use plastic bottles when coming to school. Any glass bottles need to be recycled at home.**
- We are continuing to collect old stamps, old post cards and old mobile phones, empty ink cartridges and used batteries.
- 2nd -6th class no longer use paper towels in school as they bring in their own hand towel to dry their hands.
- Class work will involve art work using recyclable materials as well as O.S.I.E under the 'Reduce Re-use and Recycle' theme.
- The children from **first to sixth class** who remember to Re-use and Recycle while dressing up for Halloween (**The Witches Walk on the 25th of October**) will receive a certificate acknowledging that they have made a difference..
- We are keeping a close eye on the gas and electricity meter and trying our best not to waste gas or electricity by turning off lights/sockets and keeping doors closed.
- We will continue to keep a close eye on our water meter.
- **This year we will also be focusing on Global Citizenship & Marine life which is the theme for our 8th Green flag but I will give you more information on this at a later stage.**
- **We will also continue to focus on travel with our walk to school on Tuesdays and cycle to school on Wednesdays. We ask for your continued support on these days.**

- **We will be organising a Climate Action week in conjunction with An Taisce from the 14th-20th Oct at our school. Teachers will be focusing on the theme of Climate change during the week. We hope to do some planting of bulbs with the younger classes as part of the week. The student council along side the Green committee will be organising a march outside our school on the 18th of Oct to make our Government and local politicians aware that enough is not being done to reduce Climate Change.**

We ask you as a parent to help us in this Green work by not using any tin foil or clingfilm on your child's lunch. You could use a paper bag or kitchen roll.

We would encourage you to bring this message of making a difference into your home and to encourage your child/children not to waste food, water or electricity and to reduce, re-use and recycle and to travel to school in a "green way". We appreciate all the support and help you can give us while working towards our 8th green flag.
